



### Search for printed resources according to Departmental libraries

1. Open the website chemTK – <https://www.chemtk.cz/en/>. Under the main search box, in the header of the page, select the Catalog button.
  - You can also open it directly via the link <https://vufind.techlib.cz/?lng=en>.
2. Select the Find button (without typing any word into the search box).
3. On the right side of the screen, there is a Narrow Search facet. Scroll down to the UCT departments filter (to the bottom) and select the department you are interested in.
  - In the footer of the UCT departments filter, click on "more..." or "see all..." to display all departments of UCT Prague with its own library.

#### Pro tip

You can refine your results list to the resources stored at a specific department at any point during a search.

- Type one or more words (book title/author's name/keyword) that you are looking for into the search box and select the Find button. Then refine the results list using the UCT departments filter.
